TIPS FOR HOSTING A SUCCESSFUL PARTY

Invitations and Communication

- Invite guests at least 1 month prior to the event date; Now more than ever schedules
 fill up quickly, be sure to give your guests plenty of time to save the date and shop for
 fabric and supplies that they can bring to the event!
- Keep costs minimal there is no need to buy formal invitations; Email, Social Media, Evite, and the good old telephone are great ways to invite and spread the word about your party!
- Send out a friendly reminder or two; Be sure to follow up with your guests a week to a few days prior to the event to remind them of the event and if you have space or your attendees are less than expect, you can always asks guests to bring a friend!

Supplies Needed

- **Fabric** Ask guests to bring fabric in the following measurements:
 - 1 Yard Kid-Friendly Print (Body of Pillowcase)
 - o 1/3 Yard Coordinating Solid (Cuff of Pillowcase)
 - 1/2 Yard Coordinating Print or Solid (Trim of Pillowcase)
- Embroidery Thread We have a team of embroiderers who do this for us but we ask for
 donations of a spool or 2 of embroidery thread per party (not per person) to use for our
 pillowcases. This thread can be collected at the party and mailed to us with your
 completed/assembled pillowcases.
- Pins Ask guests to bring 1 small box of pins to help with the assembly of the cases.
- Scissors
- **Sewing Machine** You will need approximately 1 machine per 3-4 guests.
- Iron/Ironing Board perhaps a few of your guests who do not have a sewing machine could bring an iron and/or ironing board
- **Donation Jar** We ask that guests consider bringing a small \$5.00 donation which helps us cover miscellaneous expenses such as shipping charges, packaging, and bookmarks for our pillowcases

PARTY TIPS

Party Set Up

- Divide your room so that guests are grouped into 4 different table stations:
 - o Measure/Cut Station Measuring tape, Scissors, Fabric pieces
 - Pinning Station Pins
 - o Sewing Station Items Needed: Sewing Machines (well-spaced out)
 - o Ironing Station Iron and Ironing Board
- Don't forget to set up a donation jar/envelope for guests who are able to bring a monetary donation which helps us cover expenses such as shipping charges, packaging, and bookmarks for our pillowcases.
